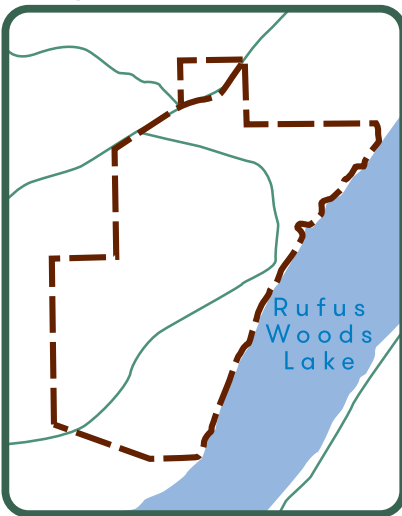




# Bridgeport State Park

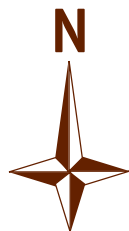

## Bridgeport State Park Boundary

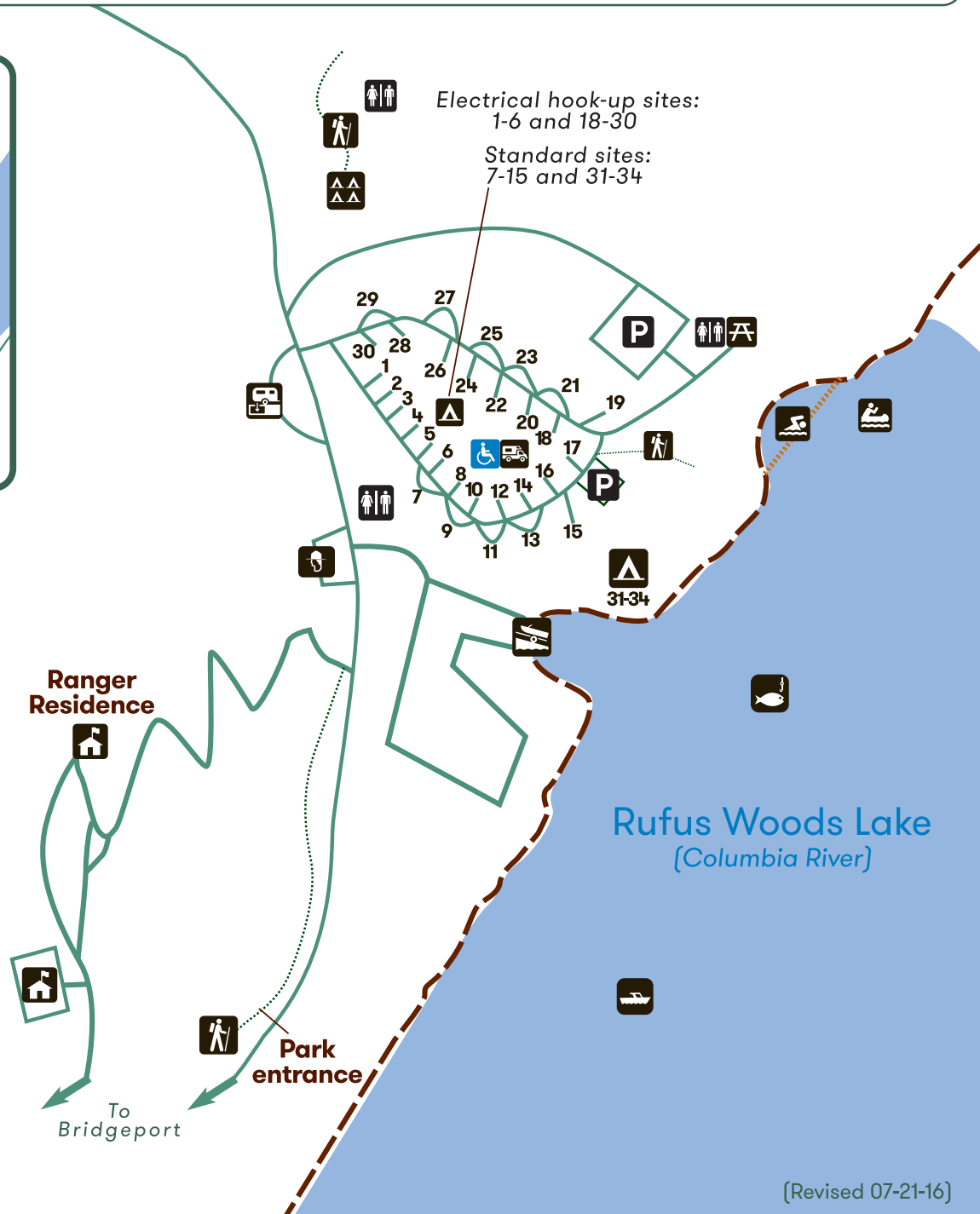


Welcome. Please remember a Discover Pass is required to visit a state park or other state-managed recreation lands.
